REFLECTING ON THE LEGACY OF DR. C.R. RAO

Dr. C.R. Rao, a renowned Indian-American mathematician and statistician, passed away on August 22, 2023, in the USA. Widely regarded as a living legend in Statistics, he was awarded with 38 honorary doctoral degrees from universities across 19 countries. Throughout his illustrious career, Dr. Rao received numerous awards and medals for his significant contributions to the fields of statistics and science. In 2023, he was honored with the International Prize in Statistics, often referred to as the "Statistics equivalent of the Nobel Prize".



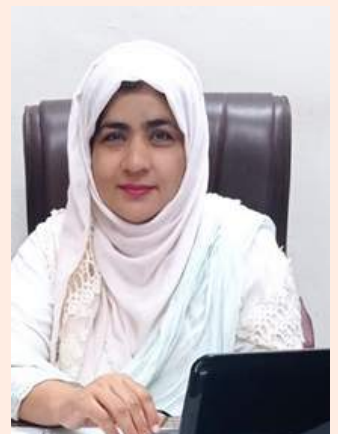
CAUCUS FOR WOMEN IN STATISTICS (CWS) SOCIETAL IMPACT AWARD

Professor Dr. Saleha Naghmi Habibullah, an alumna of Lahore College for Women University (LCWU), currently serving at Kinnaird College for Women, Lahore, and holding the position of Honorary Executive Director of PISTAR, was honored with the CWS Societal Impact Award at the JSM conference of the American Statistical Association in recognition of her remarkable achievements, instrumental efforts in bridging local statisticians with international counterparts, and her role as a distinguished ambassador representing her country on a global scale.



FUNDING FROM ELSEVIER 2023 MATHEMATICAL SCIENCES SPONSORSHIP FUND (MSSF)

Dr. Asifa Kamal, Chairperson of the Department of Statistics, has successfully secured funding for her project titled "A Step Ahead towards Diversity and Inclusivity: Facilitating Learning of Basic Mathematics and Basic Statistics for Blind Girls at Lahore College for Women University (LCWU), Lahore, Pakistan." The project has been approved for funding from the Elsevier 2023 Mathematical Sciences Sponsorship Fund (MSSF), with a generous grant of US\$4,000 to support its implementation. This initiative aligns with the



department's commitment to promote "Equity, Diversity, and Inclusion," reflecting the training received from HESSA. The project aims to empower blind girls by providing them with the necessary tools and resources to excel in basic mathematics and statistics, fostering a more inclusive learning environment at LCWU.

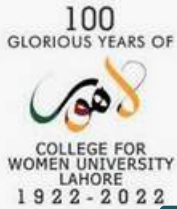


3RD BALLOTING OF HAJJ SCHEME

STUDY DESIGN AND SAMPLE SIZE CALCULATION

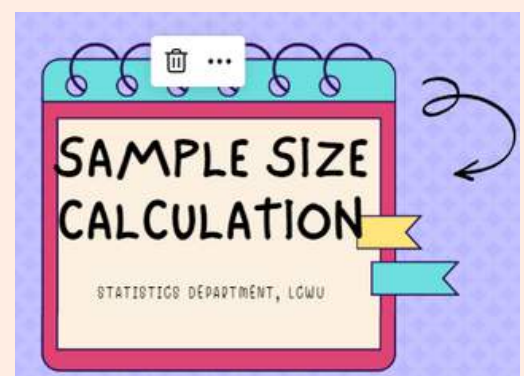
