#### **Pakistan Science Foundation**

Pakistan Science Foundation' project PSF-NSFC/JSEP/BIO-LCWU/15 titled "Management of bacterial leaf blight by biological agents" of worth 3.5 million is a linkage and exchange program between Pakistan Science Foundation and National Science Foundation of China. Dr. Khajista Jabeen (Tenured Associate Professor, Department of Botany, Lahore College for Women University, Lahore) is the Principal Investigator (PI) from Pakistan and Prof. Dr. Kou Yanjun (Rice Biologist, China National Rice Research Institute) is the Co-PI from China in this project. Under



this project awareness seminar and interactive sessions had been conducted with the participation of Chinese team in Pakistan and same will be done in China by the participation of Pakistan team.

#### Mathematical Science Sponsorship Fund (MSSF)

A project proposal of Dr. Asifa Kamal, Statistics Department titled as "A Step Ahead towards Diversity and Inclusivity: Facilitating Learning of Basic Mathematics and Basic Statistics to Blind Girls at Lahore

College for Women University (LCWU), Lahore, Pakistan" has been approved for funding from the Elsevier 2023 Mathematical Sciences Sponsorship Fund (MSSF). Dr. Mariyam Hafeez (Assistant Professor, LCWU) is the Co-Principal Investigator of the Project. The award of US\$ 4,000 have been granted in the support of the proposed initiative. The main objective of project is to promote diversity and inclusion at LCWU by facilitating blind girls in the learning process of mathematical and statistical science. The main goal of the Project is to train faculty to



facilitate teaching female blind students, a course of Mathematics and Statistics at undergraduate level. Also to develop physical resources to facilitate teaching female blind students. Statistics and Mathematics Department, LCWU, Lahore with the collaboration of Aziz Jehan Begum Trust for blinds will complete the project.





#### Pak-UK Education Gateway Student Mobility Partnership

Pak-UK Education Gateway Mobility Partnership for Students focuses on collaboration between universities in the United Kingdom and Pakistan. This project awarded to Engr. Dr. Aqsa Shabbir (Principal Investigator), Prof. Dr. Amina Muazzam (Co-PI) and Dr. Naveed Iqbal (Co-PI) of PKR 12.6 million is supported and enabled by British Council and HEC. It is set to revolutionize higher education,

fostering stronger ties and promoting equitable and diverse academic environments. It is focused on enhancing research, academic and professional collaborations between UK universities and LCWU which is Pakistan's largest women university. The project titled, "Socially Inclusive and Equitable Education as a Driver for Sustainable Development." aims to facilitate academically rigorous short-term mobility opportunities for Master's and Ph.D. students in both Pakistan and the UK.



#### **PAK-France PERIDOT Grant**

Dr. Nausheen Mazhar Chairperson and Associate Professor of the Geography Department at LCWU was awarded HEC Franco-Pakistani Hubert Curien Partnership (PHC) PERIDOT Grant, of PKR. 3.6 Million on 02/05/2023, as a Principal Investigator. The project is basically a mobility grant providing opportunities to French and Pakistani researchers to collaborate. Dr. Nausheen's project addressed SDG 13 and SDG 7. The collaboration is with Geography Department, University of Paris. The team is working on "An assessment of sedimentation trends in Tarbela reservoir in prospect of dam storage capacity: The sustainable

energy optimization in Pakistan". The grant involves mobility of PIs and PhD Students from either side, to open avenues of joint research.





#### Tehseen Industries - Standardization of polyherbal formulation containing <u>Glycyrrhiza galabra</u>

In 2023, Department of Pharmacognosy, Faculty of Pharmaceutical & Allied health Sciences signed a MOU with Tehseen Industries for the standardization of their natural formulations, for this purpose a polyherbal formulation containing *Glycyrrhiza galabra* as one of the active ingredients was selected. This industry research project of PKR 0.3 million was awarded to Dr. Muhammad Tanveer Khan (Department of Pharmacognosy). Different approaches were used to select the feasible analytical procedures and after optimization various methods a s suitable, efficient and cost effective method was finalized for the identification of the active agent (Glycyrrhizic acid)



from the formulation. The developed analytical method helped the industry to make effective quality control checks as a result standardized formulation with good quality standards was available for the ailing community.

# Soil Fertility Research Institute (SFRI), Punjab


